4. Purpose and legal basis of processing

4 a) Purpose of processing:

Your data is collected in order to:

- Fulfil the contract for the provision of our vehicles
- Comply with legal obligations (e.g. requests from authorities)
- Establish, exercise, or defend legal claims

4 b) Legal basis for processing

Your data is processed on the following legal bases:

- Contract initiation/fulfilment pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) GDPR
- Compliance with legal obligations pursuant to Article 6(1)(c) GDPR
- Protection of legitimate interests pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) GDPR

5. Categories of personal data

We process the following categories of personal data in particular:

- Master data (name, address, contact data, company data, contact person)
- Contract data (contents of the rental agreement, vehicle data, payment information, bank details)
- Communication data (emails, correspondence)
- Vehicle-related data (chassis number, mileage, condition, accident and damage reports)
- Telematics and geolocation data (location, movement profiles, operating status of the vehicles), insofar as this is necessary for the execution of the agreement or recovery of the vehicle



6. Processing of vehicle and geolocation data

Our vehicles are equipped with technical systems that can record certain items of vehicle-related data and transmit them to us or our service providers. This includes in particular

- Location data (GPS coordinates)
- Movement and usage data (e.g. speed, mileage, engine status)
- Condition and diagnostic data of the vehicle

Purpose of the processing:

- Fulfilment and processing of the rental agreement (e.g. recovery, invoicing, maintenance, claims processing)
- Ensuring compliance with contractual obligations (e.g. geographical use, place of return)
- Prevent of misuse and theft
- Assertion, exercise or defence of legal claims

Legal basis:

- Art. 6(1) point (b) GDPR (fulfilment of contract)
- Art. 6(1) point (f) GDPR (legitimate interest in the protection of property, prevention of misuse, processing of claims)

Recipients:

IT and telematics service providers, insurance companies, experts, authorities, manufacturers/suppliers (insofar as transmission of the data is required).

Special note:

The geolocation data relates primarily to the vehicle. As the vehicle is provided to a specific person for the rental period, however, personal identification cannot be ruled out. We therefore treat this data as personal data and process it in accordance with the provisions of the GDPR. We only process geolocation data if there are reasonable grounds for suspicion of unlawful behaviour in a specific case, e.g. to locate vehicles after misappropriation or theft.

 - Protecting your vital interests in the event of an accident or emergency involving one of our vehicles
- Insurance companies and claims adjusters regarding any insurance products purchased with your rental for:
 - Providing and managing the insurance product you requested
 - Managing claims under the relevant insurance policy

 - Managing claims under the Wucherpfennig & Krohn insurance policy

 - Administrative, management, accounting, and reporting purposes
- Third-party contractors and service providers, including auditors, legal advisors, and debt collection agencies for:
 - Providing the services you requested
 - Managing and protecting Wucherpfennig & Krohn's business and security
 - Detecting and protecting against fraud, theft, or misuse
 - Customer support
 - Collecting overdue payments

8. Transfer of personal data to a third country

No personal data is transferred to a third country

9. Data retention period

Your data will be stored at Wucherpfennig & Krohn GmbH for as long as necessary to fulfil the respective purpose (contract fulfilment, legal obligations, or establishment, exercise, or defence of legal claims), considering legal retention periods.

10. Data subject rights

Under the General Data Protection Regulation, you have the following rights:

If your personal data is processed, you have the right to obtain information about the data stored about you (Article 15 GDPR).

If incorrect personal data is processed, you have the right to rectification (Article 16 GDPR).

If the legal requirements are met, you may request the deletion or restriction of processing, as well as object to processing (Articles 17, 18, and 21 GDPR).

If you have consented to data processing or if a data processing contract exists and processing is carried out using automated procedures, you may have the right to data portability (Article 20 GDPR).



If you exercise any of the above rights, the organisation will review whether the legal requirements are met.

11. Obligation to provide data

You are required to provide your data. This obligation arises from the contract conclusion, for which Wucherpfennig & Krohn GmbH requires your data. If you do not provide the required data, the contract cannot be concluded with you.
